



Regulation Regarding Broadcasting Images

Dentsu Kyushu retains all rights to images of the event. The broadcasters shall observe the regulations for TV/Internet broadcast of the competition.

TV:

1. Broadcast area: The broadcaster's own territory only.
* Secondary transfer or sale of images is prohibited.
 2. Broadcast Period: Within 30 days of filming.
* After 30 days of filming, Broadcasters that wish to use images of the competition shall contact Dentsu Kyushu to obtain the approval to the usage.
 3. Broadcast program: Existing, new or special programs
 4. Usable seconds: No limitation
 5. Submission of a copy tape of the program: The broadcasters shall send a VHS/DVD copy of the program to the following address.

1. Broadcast type: Delayed broadcast after the event

 2. Broadcast Period: within the period from 4th to 31th July 2004
 3. Usable seconds: No more than 5 images of 30 seconds each.

Regulation for Coverage

Due to the competitive nature and technical aspects of the event, the organizers would appreciate if consideration is given to the participants, both human and robots. The following rules and restrictions exist to ensure the smooth and enjoyable functioning of RoboCup:

1. All coverage activities must take place in the designated coverage areas. Special attention is required for the camera position around the match courts.
2. Journalists must not impede the progress of the competition, ceremonies, or other official actions taken by the organizers.
3. The official crew, main broadcaster (KBC) and other broadcasters with broadcasting rights have priority to camera positions in all reporting activities.
4. Camera lights are prohibited. Light strobes and other devices that add illumination are prohibited during photography. (500 lux brightness is available on all courts.)
5. Wireless equipments (microphones etc.) and mobile phones near the match courts are prohibited.
6. No-smoking is permitted inside the arena. Please use designated smoking areas.
7. Follow all instructions issued by the organizers.
